Registered Nurse Immunizer/Tester

The Yorkton Tribal Council Inc is seeking one (1) individual for a **Term** position of RN Immunizer/Tester in the Health and Social Development Department.

The individual will be responsible but not limited to the following duties:

- Conducts assessments and screening of all eligible clients.
- Obtains informed consent prior to immunizations/testing.
- Prepares and administers COVID-19 vaccines/testing in accordance with established protocols.
- Provides education about after care and other possible adverse events from vaccines.
- Collects data and completes required documentation after each immunization/test.
- Identifies and manages adverse reactions such as anaphylaxis, fainting and other immediate reactions.
- Follows established protocols to maintain vaccine cold chain.
- Coordinates the set up and dismantling vaccine and testing clinics.
- Attend internal and external meetings pertaining to vaccines and testing.
- Alert and educate the public on vaccines and testing and the delivery plan.
- Completes other duties as required from time to time.

Qualifications:

- Registered and in good standing with the SRNA.
- Recent completion of certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support.
- Great verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively with internal and external contacts including co-workers, clients, and SHA contacts.
- Demonstrate sound judgment and critical thinking.
- Work independently or in a team with little to no supervision.
- Ability to advocate on behalf of stakeholders.
- Experience working with Indigenous clients is an asset but not required.
- Experience working in vaccination clinics is an asset but not required.
- Must be willing to provide a criminal record with vulnerable sector check.
- Able to effectively communicate both verbally and in writing.
- A valid Driver's License is required and must maintain throughout employment.
