Discussion

- Covid numbers are still at 8 active and 8 recovered.
- There is no set number of doses coming to Cote. Health will be vaccinating at a pace of 10 people/Day and 50 people/week.
- A ramp will be built in the back of the clinic as part of having clients come through the front and leave through the back.
- Power & Heat need to be hooked up at isolation center for the workers upstairs.
- Making list of funeral costs as far a few years back for possible reimbursement from INAC.
- Brainstorming for possible care facility. Information will be provided from Standing buffalo with making this a viable business. Using O-Mee-May Lodge as possible location.
- Christmas bonus cheques that have not been received yet are going to have a stop payment on them. They will be reprinted and mailed out.
- A 4 Year Plan on replacing all piping in the school.

Portfolio Updates

Finance
